Visual Art

DRDP VPA 1 Visual Art - Engages with tools and materials for painting or drawing or sculpting, as a primarily sensory experience.

CA Preschool Learning Foundations (Around 60 Months) - Recognize and name materials and tools used for visual arts.

PK.VA:Cr1.2 - Engage in self-directed, creative art-making.

8.VA:Cr2.1 - Demonstrate willingness to experiment, innovate, and take risks to pursue ideas, forms, and meanings that emerge in the process of artmaking or designing.

Prof.VA:Cr1.2 - Shape an artistic investigation of an aspect of present-day life using a contemporary practice of art or design.

Prof.VA:Cr2.1 - Engage in making a work of art or design without having a preconceived plan.
