By the end of the workshop, you'll leave equipped with practical tools and a copy of the WAVES curriculum, ready to foster emotional well-being in diverse settings.

WAVES students demonstrate statistically significant mood improvements after lesson participation as confirmed by Wilcoxon signed rank test analysis. This underscores WAVES' effectiveness in promoting lasting emotional well-being, making it a valuable asset for any organization.

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WAVES CURRICULUM

Thirty-five engaging trauma-informed art lessons, each lasting approximately 60 minutes. No prior art experience or training is necessary for students or facilitators, ensuring accessibility for all. With lessons aligned to California Arts Standards and CASEL 5 core SEL competencies, WAVES leverages culturally relevant pedagogy and contemporary art to promote social-emotional learning in diverse environments.
